**Introduction:** The Segment 2 driver education program consists of six (6) hours of classroom instruction which will consist of

1. Developing risk awareness.
2. Making effective decisions.
3. Fatigue factors.
4. Road rage factors.
5. Substance abuse factors.
6. Organ Donation

**Tardiness:** Students are expected to be in class on time. "Tardy" means up to ten (10) minutes late. **Students who are 10 or more minutes late will be dropped from the program. \***

**Classwork:** Students will be expected to complete, to the instructors qualifications, all worksheets, video responses, and speaker reflections/essays. All work is to be organized in the order received/presented and turned in to the instructor for grading. **Incomplete and/or poor quality work will result in the student failing the Segment 2 class.\* (Bring your own writing utensil & paper.) Students must pass the STATE test with a70% or better. Tests will be read and can be retaken 2x.**

**Responsible Behaviors:** The student should understand that the same school rules which apply during the regular school day, also apply during driver education. Since a driver license is a privilege (not a right), we expect that students exhibit a mature attitude and acceptance of responsibility. **Violation of school rules or lack of responsibility will result in the student being removed from the program.\***

## COURSE PROVISION

MPPS Driver Education will provide 6 hours of classroom instruction provided by a certified instructor. *Classroom instruction will not exceed 2 hours per day.* **There is NO make-up class.** The State of Michigan requires a minimum of six (6) hours of classroom instruction for each Segment 2 student.

**NOTICE:** This driver education provider is required to be certified by the Secretary of State. If you have any complaint which you cannot settle with this provider, please complete the Driver Education Complaint form under "Driver Programs Division" on the department of state website; [www.michigan.gov/sos](http://www.michigan.gov/sos). Completion of driver education instruction does not guarantee qualification for a driver license.

*A minimum of 30 hours of supervised driving, including 2 hours of nighttime driving, on a Level 1 license that has been held for at least 3 continuous months must be completed before a student can be accepted into Segment 2. Supervised driving is defined as driving with a licensed parent, guardian or parent designee age 21 or older.* **YOU MUST PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION OF ALL DRIVING HOURS.**

## TERMS

The parent or guardian agrees to pay the amount of \$50 which needs to be paid in full by the first day of class.

**\* Tuition is non-refundable once the student has started the program.**
